- ◆ Label items (e.g., brownies with pecans)
- ◆ Brownies, cookies, cupcakes and other smaller items can be wrapped together and sold as one large package or broken into smaller lots.
- ◆ If you wish, price your items. Otherwise, we will price them at set up.
- ◆ Please avoid baking items that require refrigeration.

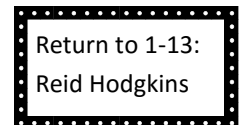
